



HONEYWELL FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) PROTOCOL

Various venues with programming affected, planning to reschedule

The Honeywell Foundation's top priority is always the health and safety of its much-valued team, volunteers, and guests. The Foundation is abiding by Indiana Governor Holcomb's mandate including precautionary social distancing to slow and prevent the spread of COVID-19 (Coronavirus), including the prohibition of public gatherings and events of 250 guests or more in the State of Indiana.

In compliance with Governor Holcomb's instructions and with an abundance of caution, the Honeywell Foundation is suspending all events at Foundation properties including the Honeywell Center, Honeywell House, Eagles Theatre, Dr. James Ford Historic Home, and Charley Creek Gardens through **Thursday, April 9**.

The Foundation is actively working with agents, managers, artists, and partners in an effort to reschedule performances when possible. Guests will receive updates via email and social media as quickly as they become available. Guests are asked to hold on to their ticket(s) as they will be honored for the rescheduled date(s). In the event of a show being cancelled on behalf of COVID-19 (Coronavirus), guests will receive a 100% refund and will be contacted directly by the Foundation with more information on how to receive the refund. If guests are unable to attend a rescheduled event, a 100% refund will be issued.

While all programs and events are suspended, Eugenia's Restaurant will remain open during normal business hours (Monday – Friday from 11 a.m. – 2 p.m. and Sundays from 11 a.m. – 2 p.m.).
